### Communication Language and Literacy

The Jolly Phonics scheme is used alongside Letters and Sounds to teach letter sounds and formation. A range of activities are ongoing throughout the year to develop speaking and listening skills, to learn and implement reading strategies and encourage independent writing.

Please read regularly with your child at home. During Term 1 and 2 we hear the children read individually, but the emphasis will change to group reading during Term 3.

### Mathematics

The children engage in various activities planned to ensure progression, starting with counting, recognising and ordering numbers to 20. These include structured play using sand and water, role-play, block play, etc. which encourage the exploration of shape, space and measures and using money
