



Class 3 Year Planner

Here are details of the topics that are planned for this year



Literacy –

Spellings will be set on **Mondays** for testing on **Friday**. Homework will be set on a **Monday** (for Y4s only) for completion by **Wednesday**. Please hear your child read regularly at home. Reading in school will generally be in a group situation.

Science –

Topics to be covered this year -
Term 1 - Light.
Term 2 - Forces and magnets.
Term 3 and 4 - Animals including humans.
Term 5 - Rocks.
Term 6 - Plants.

Maths –

Children will be set homework on **Thursday** for completion by **Monday**. Children should be secure in their multiplication tables (up to 12) by the end of Y4 therefore practice is necessary.

Art and Design –

The focuses will be as follows -
Term 1 - Romans including mosaic drawings.
Term 3 - Local art inspiration.
Term 5 - 20th century media (eg, posters.)

Topic – History and Geography –

Terms 1 and 2 - The Romans.
Term 3 and 4 - Local history focus.
Term 5 and 6 - Leisure and Entertainment in the 20th century.

Design and Technology –

Term 2 - Roman mosaics.
Term 3 - Local food.
Term 6 - Electric circuits.

PE –

Please ensure your children have their kit here every day although lessons will normally be on a **Thursday**. Games will alternate each week between **Tuesday** and **Friday**. Children need a warm tracksuit for Games in the winter. **Please note - earrings must be removed by your child for all lessons including swimming.**

French –

Children will learn classroom routines, numbers, colours, days of the week and months of the year.

ICT –

Term 1 - Creating an interactive game.
Term 2 - Design an interactive toy.
Terms 3 and 4 - HTML editing.
Terms 5 and 6 - Wikis and Blogs.

RE –

Children will learn about different religious celebrations and carry out some in-depth study of Hinduism and Sikhism.

Music –

All units will incorporate listening, singing, composing and performing.
